YOU CAN BECOME FAMOUS!

CLOCK HOURS FOR WASHINGTON MUSIC TEACHERS:

- Sign in and pick up your packets during HCNW registration.

REGISTRATION

- Pick up your registration packets as soon as you arrive. They will contain your name badge and either your keys (if you are a resident) or your meal tickets (if you are a commuter).
- Registration starts Friday at 11:00, is located in the Wheelock Student Center. Look for signs and people to guide you. (If arrive that early, please be aware that Friday lunch is **NOT** included in the registration fee, but you can pay as you go through the cafeteria.)
- **OWE MONEY?** If you have not completely paid for HCNW, go to the "**Will Call**" area, in the registration area, where you will be able to pick up your packet after you've either paid by check or credit card.

FIRST TIMERS

- If this is your first year to attend Harmony College NW, we extend a huge "welcome" and invite you to stop by the First Timers table in registration for valuable information, and a special sticker to put on your name badge!

LATE ARRIVALS - RESIDENTS

- If you arrive after Friday's dinner and during the General Session, come directly to Schneebeck Auditorium to pick up your keys and packet in the Schneebeck lobby before you head to your Session 2 class.
- If you will be arriving after 9:00 pm on Friday, your packet and keys will have been taken to the Campus Security office (on the north, or 15th St., side of Wheelock Student Center), and can be picked up there at any time during the night.

YOUR PERSONAL SCHEDULE

- Your class schedule is printed on the back of your name badge. It will be in **your registration packet**.

MEALS

- We have scheduled longer meal breaks for visiting and getting to classes.
- **Residents:** If you have registered to live on campus for the weekend, your room keys will get you into the dining room for meals from **Friday's dinner** through **Sunday's breakfast**.
- **Commuters:** If you will be commuting daily, you will receive a lanyard with a meal card on it. These must be returned to the kitchen after you get your dinner Saturday night.
- Attendees to the Arrangers Workshop and the Supercharging Your Chapter Workshop will find individual meal tickets in with your name badge.

SATURDAY NIGHT SHOW

- **BEST SHOW IN THE NORTHWEST!!!** Your registration includes our Saturday night show featuring our STARS from the weekend.
- There will be **very few** extra tickets for Saturday's show this year. They will be available, until **SOLD OUT**, during Friday's registration.

AFTERGLOWS - FRIDAY and SATURDAY

- Everyone is invited to our Afterglows to enjoy tags, singing, and visiting. Quartets and small ensembles are encouraged to sing for groups.

DORM LIFE

- Resident students and faculty will be staying in the student dorms again this year. **Don't forget the dorm halls are CO-ED. Dress appropriately for your trip down the hall!**
- We do have some internet connectivity. Login info will be available during registration. You might want to bring your "hotspot" if you have one.

LINENS

- **If you are staying in a standard room, you MUST bring your own bedding and towels.** The beds on campus are twin extra long - so bring flat sheets, or a sleeping bag, along with your pillow, washcloth, and towels, etc.
- We will have a limited number of linen sets available for rental from UPS over the weekend at \$25/set. Email Judy Galloway ahead of time and she'll save a set for you. jhgalloway47@gmail.com
- **Upgraded dorm rooms come with a set of linens (including one blanket) for your use.** Plan accordingly.

DORM KEYS

- Resident students and faculty will receive the dorm keys in their registration packets. Wear your room keys all weekend, so that you don't get locked out of your dorm or your room. ALL keys **must be returned to the box in the registration area** before you leave campus.
- **Residents: show your key lanyard as payment for your meals.**

YOU MIGHT WANT TO ALSO BRING -- It should be warm – but this is the Northwest!

- Walking shoes! Classes are scattered around the campus
- Alarm clock
- Small fan and/or umbrella
